2. Normal processing times

- (1) Passport: In 7 business days between the application and issuance (E.g. Application on Monday & issuance next Wednesday)
- (2) Visa: 5 business days between the application and issuance (E.g. Application on Monday & issuance on Friday)
- (3) Certificates: Same-day in principle (The same-day issuance is not applicable in some cases depending on the situation.)

- (1) Please check our website for the latest information before visiting us as things are subject to change according to circumstances in the future.
- (2) For non-urgent matters, we would appreciate it if you could come later when settled to avoid the congestion in the waiting room.
- (3) If you are unwell, please come after you have recovered.
