## What is Western Sydney Development ?

- The NSW Government developed "Vision of a Metropolis of Three Cities" plan to ease overconcentration of population in Sydney.
- ◆ As part of the plan, Western Parkland City is formed around the new Western Sydney Airport.


- ✓ Sydney population expected to increase from 5 million now to 8 million in 2056.



200,000 jobs Employment creation target in Aerotropolis and adjunct areas


